

Dr. David Borchers, is an academic statistician with 30 years' experience developing methods in statistical ecology. He is a current Professor and Head of Statistics for the School of Mathematics and Statistics at the University of St. Andrews. He has nearly 100 peer reviewed publications, 4 books, 6 book chapters, and 35 invited talks and workshops to his name. Dr. Borchers has developed statistical methods and software used extensively by national, international, and private conservation and management organizations. His active research interests include ecological statistics, wildlife population assessment, distance sampling, survey design, mark-recapture, hidden Markov models in ecology, sampling theory, spatial modeling, and public understanding of statistics.
