

## Emil Shukurov Dzhaparovic

Born January 19, 1938 in Frunze, the Kyrgyz SSR (Bishkek, the Kyrgyz Republic nowadays).  
Father Shukurov Dzhapar Shukurovich – was a famous scientist and statesman, people's commissar of education, during the war led the Kyrgyz Branch of the Academy of Sciences of the USSR, also headed the Department of Turkology in the Academy of Sciences of the KSSR .

Mother Shukurova Nagima Galievna worked in the system of public education.

After graduating with honors from the Kyrgyz State University in 1959 Emil Shukurov went to Moscow State University and studied post-graduate of the Biology and Soil Faculty.

During the 1962-63 years taught at Medical Institute at the Department of Social Sciences. From 1963 to 2010 he worked at the Kyrgyz Academy of Sciences at the Institute of Biology and Soil Science (research assistant, senior staff scientist, head of laboratory, assistant director, director ), at the Institute of Philosophy and Law (research assistant, senior staff scientist, deputy director of science), at the Department of Philosophy under the Presidium of the Academy of Sciences of the KSSR (senior lecturer), Academy of Management under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.

Candidate of Biological Sciences since 1968, Doctor of Geographical Sciences since 1992.  
Professor, Honored Scientist of the Kyrgyz Republic, Honored Worker of Nature Protection of Kyrgyzstan. Awarded the state medal Dunk. He has about 400 scientific publications. Public figure. Chairman of the Ecological Movement of Kyrgyzstan, Deputy Chairman of the Environmental Society Aleine +, Head of the Public Council of Archa, a member of the International Union for the Conservation of Nature, an associate member of Fauna and Flora International, a member of the New York Academy of Sciences, the ISEU (International Socio-Ecological Union).

Managed and participated in many projects related to nature protection, a member of the social activist of the UNESCO National Commission.
